Botany Department: Contract Work

The Botany Department undertakes botanical surveys and provides specialist input into Environmental Impact Assessments (EIAs) to raise funds.

Assistance is provided through:

- Plant identifications for EIA consultants.
- The housing of specimens collected during an EIA for future reference.
- Specialist input through botanical surveys for EIAs in the Northern Cape, whenever possible.

A reasonable fee is charged for botanical surveys and plant identifications for EIAs. A number of stone plants that occur in the Northern Cape are listed in the *Red Data List of Southern African Plants*. EIAs help protect these plants.
