Resource Centre

The Resource Centre has two functions:

- As a reference centre for pupils and teachers with information in books, magazines, charts, photographs, videos and on computer.
- As a discovery centre for school-going children, where pupils can be exposed to real objects and learn by themselves.

The Resource Centre is an ideal venue for workshops with small groups of teachers and a number have been held here, focusing primarily on the development and use of teaching resources for the new outcomes based curriculum.



Discovery Room

The Discovery Room is a hands-on touch and activity centre specifically for pre-school children. During special lessons, young children can study their bodies (a growth chart, distorting mirrors, a skeleton in a cave), their senses (a touch panel and simple musical and optical instruments) and their world (animal homes in the veld, the garden, in a tree, in water and underground).
